Sydenham College is committed towards preserving the environment. It adopts various best practice of continuing the legacy of "Sydenham Thinks Green".


7.1.5	Sydenham Green Campus Initiatives

2	Pedestrian-friendly pathways	Even though the campus area is small, Sydenham college has pedestrian friendly pathways. The pathways are tiled and well maintained




