One lesson learned is the importance of redundancy in communication systems.

Global Collaboration for Lunar Success:



Chandrayaan-3's Vikram lander weighs in at 1,752 kilograms—about as much as a small car and about 280 kilograms heavier than its predecessor. Most of that additional weight is linked to extra precautions the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) built in after the disappointing crash landing in 2019. Not only does Vikram carry more fuel to better stay on its intended trajectory to the lunar surface, it also has far more redundancies and safeguards to gracefully touch down this time around. These include strengthened legs to absorb the mechanical shock of touchdown and a velocity sensor for enhanced navigation well various software measurements, as as improvements to accommodate potential failures. All this, combined with numerous ground tests, has ISRO officials confident that this time they will stick to the landing.

Chandrayaan 3's mission extends beyond conquering the challenges that Chandrayaan 2 faced. It is a stepping stone toward a future where India's lunar ambitions continue to flourish. The mission's success could unlock new frontiers of scientific discovery, unveiling insights into lunar geology, composition, and potentially even the origins of the moon itself. 

Sydenham Alumni Event: CPR Demo and Training Session Organised in Association with The American Heart Association

We are delighted to share the news that Sydenham College of Commerce and Economics recently organized an informative CPR demonstration and training session in collaboration with The American Heart Association. This article aspires to impart knowledge and raise awareness among individuals about the importance of CPR. The main objective was to educate participants on the principles of CPR, thereby enabling them to respond efficiently during emergencies and potentially save lives.

CPR or Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation holds the key to revive individuals who have experienced sudden cardiac arrests. This procedure targets the restoration of blood circulation and oxygen supply to crucial organs, especially the brain. Statistics from the American Heart Association underline the importance of immediate CPR – it can substantially enhance the survival odds for individuals facing cardiac arrests.

The event's inaugural segment featured an insightful introduction to CPR. Trainers elaborated on the procedure's significance across various scenarios and dispelled common myths that tend to surround it. These clarifications addressed concerns regarding the likelihood of inadvertently harming the victim or contracting diseases through performing CPR.

A key highlight of the event was the hands-on session conducted by Divay Trikha. Attendees were exposed to the intricate techniques of CPR – from assessing the situation and determining responsiveness to initiating chest compressions and administering rescue breaths. Moreover, participants received guidance on utilizing automated external defibrillators (AEDs), devices designed to deliver controlled electric shocks to restart the heart's rhythm. The practice session on manikins provided participants with a tangible experience of these life-saving manoeuvres, all under the vigilant supervision of experienced trainers.





CPR is a skill that anyone, from parents and teachers to coworkers and bystanders – can acquire. Here are the steps to follow if you encounter someone who needs CPR:

- 1. Check for responsiveness and call for help. Tap the person's shoulder and ask loudly, "Are you okay?" If there is no response, call emergence services or ask someone nearby to do so. Tell them to bring an automated external defibrillator (AED) if available.
- 2. Start chest compressions. Place the heel of one hand on the centre of the person's chest, and the other hand on top of the first. Interlock your fingers and keep your arms straight. Push hard and fast, at least 100 times per minute, and at least 2 inches deep. Allow the chest to recoil fully between each compression.
- 3. Give rescue breaths. After 30 compressions, tilt the person's head back and lift their chin. Pinch their nose and seal your mouth over theirs. Blow into their mouth for one second and watch for their chest to rise. If it does, give another breath. If not, reposition their head and try again.
- 4. Repeat until help arrives. Continue with 30 compressions and 2 breaths until the person starts breathing, an AED is ready to use, or a trained responder takes over.

The event went beyond practical training, incorporating presentations, impactful videos, and interactive discussions to enhance participants' understanding of CPR and its real-world applications. Trainers actively engaged with attendees, addressing questions ranging from identifying cardiac arrest symptoms to managing choking incidents and coping with the emotional aspects of administering CPR.

We are pleased to report that the event was a success, equipping participants with valuable life-saving skills applicable in critical situations. We extend our gratitude to the American Heart Association and Divay Trikha for their vital contributions to the event's success. The enthusiastic participation of students and alumni showcased their dedication to community.

The ripple effect of this CPR training event is substantial. By disseminating awareness about CPR and its pivotal role, our aim is to inspire more individuals to embrace this essential skillset.
