**A) Documents required for GENERAL (OPEN) CATEGORY student:**

1. Printed copy of Online Application form signed by the student and Parents

3. SSC / mark sheet (original) + (Two photo copies)
4. Leaving Certificate / Transference certificate (original) + (Two photo copies)
5. Migration Certificate. (If other than Maharashtra board) (original) + (Two photo copies)
6. Academic Bank of Credits (ABC – Id)- print out (01 Copy)
7. Gap Certificate (Affidavit) in case student has Gap in studies.
8. Declaration form
9. Undertaking form (if Applicable)
10. Aadhar card (one photo copy)

**B) Documents required for RESERVED CATEGORY student:**

1. Document 01-10 as above
2. Caste certificate issued by Government of Maharashtra for students from (SC/ST/VJ/NT/OBC/SBC/EWS) (original) + (three Photo copies)
3. Non creamy layer Certificate of the CURRENT YEAR (VJ/NT/OBC/SBC) + (02 Photo copies)
4. Other certificates pertaining to respective category

**C) Candidates seeking admission under physically challenged/defense/ freedom fighter/ government transfer, etc. quota should submit the following additional documents:**

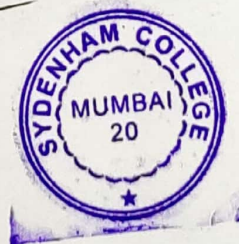
1. Attested photocopy of the Certificate from the competent government authority certifying the nature and percentage of disability, in case of candidate who applies under Disability Quota.
2. Attested photocopy of the Certificate from Commanding Officer, in case of candidate who applies under Defence Quota.
3. Attested photocopy of the Letter of Transfer for that year, in case of children of transferred Central/State Government Employee.
4. Attested photocopy of documentary proof, in case of children/grandchildren of Freedom Fighter.
5. Attested photocopy of the documentary proof, in case of women who are widowed/separated

**N.B.: Original documents (except leaving certificate, migration) will be returned to candidate after verification**
